The Jim Levine Legacy Scholarship (JLLS) honors a Youth Project leader, mentor and friend for his lifetime commitment in making a difference in the lives of children and youth in Mendocino County. Jim Levine began his nearly 40 year career as a para-professional Youth Worker, and went on to become the Executive Director of the “Youth Project”. His interest in youth came from his innate kindness coupled with a deep understanding of what can make a difference in a child’s life. In the development of youth intervention and prevention services at the Youth Project, Jim implemented the Positive Youth Development (PYD) approach. PYD is a prosocial approach that engages youth within their communities, schools, organizations, peer groups, and families in a manner that recognizes and enhances youth strengths, and promotes positive outcomes for young people while providing opportunities and supports so they may overcome adversity and build upon leadership skills. To this day, Positive Youth Development is the foundational core of all Youth Project services.

Jim Levine was known throughout Mendocino County, the State of California, and the nation as a mentor and advocate for high risk children, youth and young adults. Many of the youth he directly served or who participated in Youth Project prevention activities have followed his footsteps and as adults obtained certification or college degrees and work in the human services field.

Each year, six graduating seniors who attend high school in Mendocino County are awarded the Jim Levine Legacy Scholarship. The JLLS awards are stewarded and presented by the Board of Directors of the non-profit affiliate within Mendocino County Youth Project, the Mendocino Family & Youth Services. As a graduating senior we welcome your application and wish you success!

Application Requirements

2019 Graduating High School Seniors within Mendocino County's private and public schools, are invited to apply for the Jim Levine Legacy Scholarship. The application form in this packet, with all of the required supporting documentation, must be completed and received by May 03, 2019, at the address noted on the bottom of page 1. Applications received after that date will not be accepted. The Jim Levine Legacy Scholarship Committee may contact the applicant for a personal interview.

The application packet must include the following, with pages clipped together:

1. **A completed 2019 Scholarship Application Form.** Please print so that the committee can read it.
2. **Provide a two-page essay on why you should receive the Jim Levine Legacy Scholarship.** The two-page essay must be typed, double spaced, with one-inch margins, and 12 point font. Submit one copy only.
 - a. Criteria for successful applicants must include an essay detailing a personal, educational or family challenge that was overcome in order for them to finish high school and apply to and be accepted at an accredited college, university or vocational school. The Jim Levine Legacy Scholarship committee is interested in supporting students who have faced challenges in their life, prior to graduating from high school. These students did not originally intend to go to college or vocational school when they first entered high school or had difficulty achieving college prep grades throughout their high school years due to personal challenges. In your essay describe the challenges that you overcame.
 - b. Next, describe your involvement in school, volunteerism or work activities.
 - c. State a clear vocational/educational goal you have for your future, and describe why you have chosen it.
3. **Two Letters of Reference are required.** The Letters of Reference may be attached to the application, mailed, or emailed. Explain how your references will arrive if they are not attached to your application packet. The address for mailing is located on the bottom of page 1. 4. **High school transcript and any other transcript that supports your application** (i.e. coursework at Mendocino College).

Application Scoring Criteria:

100 total possible points

Essay:

80 points

1. Describe the life challenges you have faced on your path to graduating from high school. Explain how overcoming these challenges has prepared you to enter college or vocational school. (up to 50 points)
2. Describe volunteer or work activities you have performed at school, or in the community that were a part of your decision to further your education. (up to 10 points)
3. Describe a clear educational or vocational goal. (up to 10 points)
4. Essay Composition. Including correct spelling, punctuation and grammar. (up to 10 points)

Reference Letters:

20 points

1. Provision of two reference letters. Your references may be attached to your application packet, or mailed or hand delivered. Provide two letters of reference from non-relatives. Preferred references are adults who support your future goals and the challenges you overcame. **At least one letter should be from a high school teacher or counselor.** Paper clip letters to application or have your reference email their letter to us at rsmellus@mcyp.org

If you are awarded a scholarship you will be required to submit proof of enrollment via the acceptance letter of an accredited college, university or vocational school by August 2019. Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the school where you have been accepted and enrolled for 2019-20. **If you have been accepted, provide a copy of your acceptance in the application packet**
